By assisting the doctors and other emergency personnel in establishing a good and patent airway by laying him flat on bed or in any other surface with head and chin up technique, simultaneously taking his vitals or by connecting him in a cardiac monitoring machine, by putting IV line to facilitate the easy administration of emergency drugs for reviving the patient or to minimize the pain and discomfort That the pt. has while we are giving artificial ventilation.
- In addition to, to the final and only last thing in order to rescue the striving patient is when time comes and the patient losses his consciousness, now CPR will be applied, if the patient cannot be revive, ACLS and defibrillation follows until the patient return his consciousness.
- c. LACERATED WOUNDS: By providing and applying of pressure in the affected part to avoid a huge loss or discharge of blood coming out from the blood vessels.
- BURNS; First, trying to assess the severity of burn of the patient. First check the vital signs of pt. Cleans the wound, then apply povidone iodine, then flammazine then cover it by gauze, but in third degree we will add fucidine ointment and cover by gauze., then ATS.
- e. VEHICULAR AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS; Immobilize the patient, take the vital signs, established a patent airway & IV line, then the cardiac monitoring machine with defibrillator, and simultaneously while the doctor and nurse assesses the airway, if there is no airway and there is loss of consciousness, insertion of ET tube will followed or by tracheostomy if something worse might happen and assist the doctors of any STAT orders.
